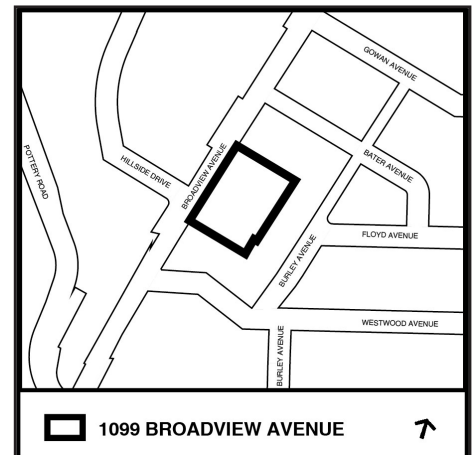

Proposal

The City of Toronto Planning Division has received an application to amend the Official Plan and the Zoning By-law for the property at 1099 Broadview Avenue. The proposal is for a 10-storey residential apartment building with approximately 395 square metres of non-residential space on the ground floor. The proposal includes an on-site parkland dedication of approximately 385 square metres at the southwest corner of the site.
