Height: Medium; 20'-30' in twenty years;
up to 30'-60' tall

Growth: Fast

Width: 30'-50' spread

Light: Full sun, partial sun, or part-shade

Water: XX

Soil: Prefers moist, well-drained soil;
extended flooding okay

Shape: Rounded, spreading

Leaves: Showy yellow leaves in fall

Fruit: Round black or purple drupes;
eaten by wildlife in the winter;
edible for humans
